

Losing Medicaid coverage?

Who can apply?

If you have lost Medicaid coverage, you may qualify **Special Enrollment Period**.

- You have 90 days to apply and enroll in a Marketplace plan after your Medicaid coverage ends.
- In many cases, your coverage can start as soon as the first day of the next month.
- If you do not apply during this time, you can apply during the next Open Enrollment Period, which begins November 1 and ends December 31.

Virginians may be eligible for financial assistance depending on their household size and income.

- Prescriptions
- Hospitalizations

- Rehabilitation services
